Located in Toronto's buzzy Queen Street East, this 1891-built hotel offers 57 high-

style rooms, and one spacious suite, in a

meticulously restored landmark building.

The decor dials up a vintage vibe. All rooms come with a vinyl record player and a minibar stocked with local treats. Some rooms feature private outdoor terraces.

Enjoy a free glass of wine (4:30 to 6:30 p.m.) in the Bistro + Bar off the lobby before heading to The Rooftop for 360-degree views of the city skyline.

Skip the elevator as the stairwell features a timeline of the building's history. There's a complimentary Lincoln car service to anywhere within five kilometres of the hotel.

The Broadview is located in the eclectic Leslieville neighbourhood, which is emerging as one of the city's hippest place to dine, drink and shop. —Christy Wright

The rooftop bar, Everdene, serves up handcrafted libations. Try the Love, Honor, and Betrayal, made with Aviation Gin, apricot, lemon juice, lavender and Moët Impérial.

Sign up for the hotel's free membership program, The Know, for room discounts, upgrades and complimentary cocktails at The Spirit Hour in the Commons Club.

Venture to The Ferry Building for takehome gifts, like vases from Heath Ceramics, or enjoy a gingerbread cupcake at Parisianinspired bakery Miette. —Jennie Nunn

The 492 rooms offer views of the interior atrium or the surrounding Hill Country.
